

Interview: Amy Perkins Inteviews Fred Allen

Amy Perkins interviewed Fred Allen who informed members that he was born in Northern California, then moving to Chicago and back to Northern California. He has two brothers and a sister. His family history is that his parents are both from the state of New York. He further revealed that his grandmother held "anti-suffrage" views when the movement first started. He worked for Wells Fargo and in



his retirement loves to travel and has developed a hobby in photography. He mentioned that while working in Northern California, former member Cal Goodridge introduced him to Rotary and that he followed Cal to Santa Barbara and Rotary Club of Santa Barbara North. His pet peeve is that today employment is too temporary, whereas in his younger days, employment was from cradle to the grave employment. His wish for the world is that a solution can be found for the ISIS problem in the East.

Program - Karl Zalazowski and Erich Kortz - Cal Coastal Rural Development Corporation



Karl, who has a CPA and started in banking indicated that in 1982, rural farmers in Salinas Valley banded together to form an agency that would lend money to small farmers during their season of need. When the state of California asked for proposals to develop



an agency that would lend money to farmers, they quickly applied and the Rural Development Corporation was formed. The agency has evolved so that it handles six different programs.

Erich explained each of the programs:

- The "Farm Loan" program uses U.S. Department of Agriculture financing to provide direct loans.
- The "504 Loan Program offers direct loans funded through the Small Business Administration.
- The Microloan Program offers credit and technical assistance to new or expanding small enterprises.
- The "Intermediary Relending" program offers business loans in rural areas.
- The "Monterey County Revolving Loan Fund" offers loans to busi nesses located in Monterey County.
- The "Loan Guarantee" program provides loans to business enterprises that will create or retain jobs.

It was mentioned that many of their clients are referrals from commercial banks that are unable to provide the assistance needed by applicants.
